Combined Training Changes

Competitors may enter the combined training as part of a team and once as an individual **OR** twice as an individual only, providing the dressage test is different. The SJ height may be either 75cm or 85cm, so a competitor could jump the same height twice.

There are also two new individual sections as follows:

- A novice test, which feeds into the 75cm SJ
- A prelim test which feeds into the 85cm SJ.

There are different dressage tests for each team member, two prelim tests and two novice tests.

Team Tests will be as follows (These can also be entered as individuals):

- BE90 Dressage 91 (2009) – 75cm
- BE90 Dressage 95 (2012) – 75cm
- BE 100 Dressage 101 (2009) – 85cm
- BE 100 Dressage 102 (2010) – 85cm

Individual Tests will be as follows:

- BE100 Dressage 106 (2012) – 75cm (individuals only)
- BE90 Dressage 96 (2016) – 85cm (individuals only)

At the Championships the two individual sections will also be counted towards the Overall Individual.

JUNIORS

CLASS 1T: Junior Team Combined Training Qualifier

For teams of three/four Juniors. Each member from the team will ride a different dressage test as follows:

- BE90 Dressage 91 (2009) & 75cm Show Jumping
- BE90 Dressage 95 (2012) & 75cm Show Jumping
- BE100 Dressage 101 (2009) & 85cm Show Jumping
- BE100 Dressage 102 (2010) & 85cm Show Jumping

The best three scores to count.

Team rosettes 1st to 6th place, Individual Arena rosettes 1st to 6th place

CLASS 1A: Junior Individual BE90 Dressage 91 (2009)/75cm Show Jumping

CLASS 1B: Junior Individual BE90 Dressage 95 (2012)/75cm Show Jumping

CLASS 1C: Junior Individual BE100 Dressage 101 (2009)/85cm Show Jumping

CLASS 1D: Junior Individual BE100 Dressage 102 (2010)/85cm Show Jumping

CLASS 2: Junior Individual Novice/75cm Combined Training Qualifier

BE100 Dressage 106 (2012) – 75cm Show Jumping (individuals only). Rosettes 1st to 6th place

CLASS 3: Junior Individual Prelim/85cm Combined Training Qualifier

BE90 Dressage 96 (2016) – 85cm Show Jumping. (individuals only). Rosettes 1st to 6th place

SENIORS

CLASS 4T: Senior Team Combined Training Qualifier

For teams of three/four Juniors. Each member from the team will ride a different dressage test as follows:

- BE90 Dressage 91 (2009) & 75cm Show Jumping
- BE90 Dressage 95 (2012) & 75cm Show Jumping
- BE100 Dressage 101 (2009) & 85cm Show Jumping
- BE100 Dressage 102 (2010) & 85cm Show Jumping

The best three scores to count.

CLASS 4A: Senior Individual BE90 Dressage 91 (2009)/75cm Show Jumping

CLASS 4B: Senior Individual BE90 Dressage 95 (2012)/75cm Show Jumping

CLASS 4C: Senior Individual BE100 Dressage 101 (2009)/85cm Show Jumping

CLASS 4D: Senior Individual BE100 Dressage 102 (2010)/85cm Show Jumping

CLASS 5: Senior Individual Novice/75cm Combined Training Qualifier

BE100 Dressage 106 (2012) – 75cm Show Jumping (individuals only). Rosettes 1st to 6th place

CLASS 6: Senior Individual Prelim/85cm Combined Training Qualifier

BE90 Dressage 96 (2016) – 85cm Show Jumping. (individuals only). Rosettes 1st to 6th place

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must be made on the official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Winter Area Qualifiers. Entries, even if made by Equo, should also be submitted to the Entries Secretary on the Official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Festival of the Horse Area Qualifiers.
2. The committee/landowner or anyone acting for these will not be held responsible for any loss/accident to persons, animal or property however caused.
3. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
4. The judge's decision and that of the official steward is final.
5. Questions about the scoring must be made to the secretary. Objections and appeals to be made in writing, accompanied by a £10.00 deposit to the secretary within 10 minutes of the posting of the results of the class.
6. This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules 2019.
7. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.
8. Vaccination Certificates: As stated in the rules, all BRC qualifying teams must be prepared to show their horse's passports and complete vaccination records on the day of the competition. Team Managers should ensure these are correct. Please send a copy of each horse's flu vaccination record with the entries (unless already on Area database). Any incorrect certificates will result in exclusion from the qualifying competition. Vaccinations need to have been administered a minimum of 6 clear days BEFORE competition
9. Entries will not be accepted without the correct fee, either BACS, EQUO or by Cheque. Cheques should be payable to 'Frampton Family Riding Club', BACS payments can be made, contact the entries secretary for BACS details
10. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries.
11. Competitors must always follow the instructions of stewards.
12. All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.
13. Only persons and/or horses competing may use the warm-up facilities. Competitors may only warm-up in the designated areas. Lunging is not permitted.
14. Horses may not be left unattended tied to horseboxes or trailers. Competitors must clear any dung/droppings.
15. Dogs must always be kept on leads.
16. Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear as per BRC rules:
 - **Hard hats must be worn and chin strap fastened by all riders when mounted, conforming to PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must be BSI Kitemark OR ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a) and must be SEI Mark OR Snell E2001 and must have Official SNELL label and number OR AS/NZS 3838 (2006) and must have SAI Global Mark.**
 - **NO OTHER SPECIFICATION WILL BE PERMITTED.**
 - **All competitors must have a BE, BRC or PC Official AQUA hat tag.**
 - **Failure to comply with these BRC rules will result in elimination.**
17. **Health and Safety** - The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials and Stewards.
18. **Legal Liability** - Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither the committee of Frampton Family Riding Club nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

All persons attending this event will be deemed to have accepted these rules and conditions.
