Classes 1, 2, 7 and 8 are open to all riders.

Class 1: Open Dressage Only – Prelim 7 (2002)

Class 2: Open Dressage Only – Prelim 13 (2006)

Classes 1 & 2 Rosettes to 6th place in each class

Combined Training

Class 3: BRC Fibre-Beet Festival of the Horse Junior Team Combined Training Qualifier

For teams of three/four Juniors only with the best three scores to count and individuals. Two team members to ride BRC HT 90Q (2013) test with 75cm showjumping and two team members to ride BRC HT100Q (2013) test with 85cm showjumping. Please see BRC Rules for 2017 regarding eligibility.

Team rosettes for 1st -6th. All individual scores for the BRC HT 90Q (2013) test with 75cm showjumping will be included in class 5 and all individual scores for the BRC HT100Q (2013) test with 85cm showjumping will be added to class 5 or 6.

Class 4: BRC Fibre-Beet Festival of the Horse Senior Team Combined Training Qualifier

For teams of three/four Seniors only with the best three scores to count and individuals. Two team members to ride BRC HT 90Q (2013) test with 75cm showjumping and two team members to ride BRC HT100Q (2013) test with 85cm showjumping. Please see BRC Rules for 2017 regarding eligibility.

Team rosettes for 1st -6th. All individual scores for the BRC HT 90Q (2013) test with 75cm showjumping will be included in class 5 and all individual scores for the BRC HT100Q (2013) test with 85cm showjumping will be added to class 5 or 6.

Class 5: BRC Fibre-Beet Festival of the Horse Individual Qualifier- Prelim

Individual qualifying competition open to Juniors and Seniors - Dressage test BRC HT 90Q (2013) Showjumping not exceeding 75cm. Individual scores from classes 3 & 4 to be included in this class. Individual rosettes 1st – 6th in each arena with stunning sash to overall winner.

Class 6: BRC Fibre-Beet Festival of the Horse Individual Qualifier- Novice

Individual competition open to Juniors and Seniors - Dressage test BRC HT 100Q (2013) Showjumping not exceeding 85cm. Individual scores from classes 3 & 4 to be included in this class. Individual rosettes 1st – 6th in each arena with stunning sash to overall winner.

Class 7: Open Individual Prelim Combined Training

Individual competition open to Juniors and Seniors - Dressage test BRC HT 90Q (2013) Showjumping not exceeding 75cm. Individual rosettes 1st – 6th.

Class 8: Open Individual Novice Combined Training

Individual competition open to Juniors and Seniors - Dressage test BRC HT 100Q (2013) Showjumping not exceeding 85cm. Individual rosettes 1st – 6th.

Please note- where clubs are unable to enter a whole team or have an imbalance of riders at the two levels, individual qualifying entries will be accepted.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must be made on the official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Winter Area Qualifiers.
2. The committee/landowner or anyone acting for these will not be held responsible for any loss/accident to persons, animal or property however caused.
3. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
4. The judge's decision and that of the official steward is final.
5. Classes 1& 2 may be combined by level, and prizes awarded on percentage if entries are small.
6. Questions about the scoring must be made to the secretary. Objections and appeals to be made in writing, accompanied by a £10.00 deposit to the secretary within 10 minutes of the posting of the results of the class.
7. This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules 2018.
8. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.
9. Vaccination Certificates: As stated in the rules, all BRC qualifying teams must be prepared to show their horse's passports and complete vaccination records on the day of the competition. Chef D'Equipes should ensure these are correct. Please send a copy of each horse's flu vaccination record with the entries (unless already on Area database). Any incorrect certificates will result in exclusion from the qualifying competition.
10. Entries will not be accepted without the correct fee. Cheques should be payable to 'Frampton Family Riding Club'.
11. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries.
12. Competitors must follow the instructions of stewards at all times.
13. All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.
14. Only persons and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities. Competitors may only warm up in the designated areas. Lunging is not permitted.
15. Horses may not be left unattended tied to horseboxes or trailers.
16. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
17. Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear as per BRC rules:
Hard hats must be worn and chin strap fastened by all riders when mounted, conforming to PAS015 (1998 or 2011) and must be BSI Kitemark OR ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a) and must be SEI Mark OR Snell E2001 and must have Official SNELL label and number OR AS/NZS 3838 (2006) and must have SAI Global Mark. NO OTHER SPECIFICATION WILL BE PERMITTED. All competitors must have a BRC Official ORANGE hat tag. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
18. **Health and Safety** - The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials and Stewards.
19. **Legal Liability** - Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither the committee of Frampton Family Riding Club nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted these rules and conditions.
