Paramedics in attendance, Vet on call

The event will run on grass. (2 arenas)

**1 helper per team for ½ day required with all entries**

**Class 1: Style Jumping** BRC Senior and Junior Team / Individual Qualifier and **SWWRC Team qualifier**.from 9am. Height Section A 75cm (*No BE/BS points allowed*)

Section B 85cm. (*Horse/pony may have 10 BE points/£225 BS*)

*\*Teams have 2 riders in section A and 2 in Section B*

*(Teams entering SWWRC only may enter mixed sen/jun teams, but no horse may compete twice.)*

**Class 2: 70cm** BRC Senior and Junior Novice Team/Individual Qualifier.

( R1 70cm, R2 75cm, jump-off in 2<sup>nd</sup> round timed will run as 2 phase with 2 fences set at 80cm)

*Horse /pony may not have BE/BS points except Club points at 70/80cm (see rule book for further detail)*

**Class 3: 80cm** BRC Senior and Junior Novice Team/Individual Qualifier and **SWWRC Team qualifier**.

(R1 80cm, R2 85cm, jump-off in 2<sup>nd</sup> round timed will run as 2 phase with 2 fences set at 90cm)

*Horse /pony may have 1 BE point but no BS points (see rule book for further detail)*

*(Teams entering SWWRC only may enter mixed sen/jun teams, but no horse may compete twice.)*

**Class 4: 90cm** BRC Senior and Junior Intermediate Team/Individual Qualifier

( R1 90cm, R2 95, jump-off in 2<sup>nd</sup> round timed will run as 2 phase with 2 fences set at 100cm)

*Horse /pony may have up to 20 BE points and 500 BS points*

**Class 5: 1m** BRC Senior/Junior Team/Individual Qualifier

(Teams in this class may be mixed Senior/Junior)

( R1 1m, R2 1m 05cm, jump-off in 2<sup>nd</sup> round timed will run as 2 phase with 2 fences set at 1m10)

*Horse /pony may have up to 60 BE points and 999 BS points*

**Class 6: 1m10** BRC Senior/Junior Team/Individual Qualifier

(Teams in this class may be mixed Senior/Junior)

( R1 1m10, R2 1m 15cm, jump-off in 2<sup>nd</sup> round timed will run as 2 phase with 2 fences set at 1m20)

### Rules

- The BRC qualifier will be run under British Riding Club rules 2018.
- The Regional Qualifier (SWWRC) will run under BRC rules except as specified:
  - i) No prelim entry fee required
  - ii) Team only competition
  - iii) Teams not entered for the BRC qualifiers may be mixed Sen/Jun
- ALL HORSES/PONIES MUST HAVE A VACCINATION RECORD COMPLYING WITH BRC RULES, WHICH MUST BE BROUGHT ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CHEF D'EQUIPE TO ENSURE THESE ARE CORRECT. ANY INCORRECT CERTIFICATES WILL RESULT IN THAT TEAM MEMBER'S DISQUALIFICATION.
- Chefs d'equipe should check the full BRC eligibility criteria for all horses and riders in the qualifying classes.
- Declarations for BRC qualifiers should be presented to the Secretary prior to the start of the Class. Alternatively they may be emailed to [tam.thornton@btinternet.com](mailto:tam.thornton@btinternet.com) up to 6pm on the previous evening. Only simple changes to teams will be permitted after close of entries (ie horse/rider replacing existing position in a team). Any other changes will incur an additional admin fee £10,
- Entries will not be accepted without the correct entry fees. Cheques should be made payable to Swindon Riding Club. Teams should send a **single** Riding Club cheque to accompany the Area Entry Form, or arrange BACS payment.
- In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries.
- Hats up to current standards with 3 point restraining harness **MUST** be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. All hats must have a current BRC tag **PRIOR TO RIDING.**
- BRC health and safety guidelines apply at all times
- Neither SDRC, BRC Area 9 or Rabson Manor will hold themselves responsible for any accident to persons, property and/or horses attending this show.
- The judges decision is FINAL
- **ONLY** persons and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities
- Competitors are requested not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes in the box park
- Horses must not be tied to horseboxes or trailers and left unattended
- All ridden horses/ponies must be 4 yrs or over
- Objections to be made to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the end of the class and accompanied by a £10 deposit
- All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.
- BRC rules are available on the BRC website. SWWRC rules are available on the Area 9 website.

### Championship Dates

BRC National Championships: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> September, Lincoln Showground

SWWRC Championships: Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> August, Hartpury EC.

Riders should check they are available to compete if entering for either of these championships.

NB All teams entered in classes 1 and 2 are eligible for the Regional Championships, but no team will qualify for both national and regional championships.

Only those teams declared for the BRC National Championships who have paid BRC prelim entries can qualify for Lincoln.
