

Standard Rules and Regulations

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, the organisers accept no liability for any loss or damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any property or persons howsoever arising.

Only horses of four years and over may be ridden at the event.

The judge's decision is final in all cases.

The committee reserves the right to refuse entry without reason, disqualify competitors for unreasonable conduct, alter or vary the programme in any way, as deemed necessary, without prior notification.

All complaints must be lodged with the secretary, in writing, within 10 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a deposit of £25, returnable if the complaint is upheld.

Correct dress and tack must be worn. The competition will be judged under current Affiliated Riding Club Rules (available on request).

Riders must wear a BSI approved hat with 3 point harness while mounted, and should not wear any jewellery. Long hair should be in a hair net or tied back above the collar. Horses may only be ridden in a permitted snaffle bridle. No boots, bandages or martingales to be worn. (breastplates or neck strap may be worn)

Entries must be received by the closing date. In the event of high entries being received, classes may be filled prior to the closing date.

The organiser has overall responsibility for Health and Safety.

Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times, and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. In the case of emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999 from the nearest phone.

Horses are easily frightened and can be dangerous. Please keep clear of horse areas/lanes and avoid behaviour which might alarm horses. Dogs must be kept on leads and under close control.

Children must be supervised at all times.
