Show Jumping Team and Individual Max height in first part 110cm

This competition will run as a single-phase competition, which will combine the first round and the jump-off. The first half of the course should be set at the class height, with the second part of the course timed and set at jump-off height.

The jump-off will follow straight on from the first part of the course without stopping. Should a team member be eliminated before reaching the jump-off phase they will NOT continue forward to the jump-off section and the team will continue as a team of three.

Numbers in the warmup will be limited

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All entries must be made on the official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Winter Area Qualifiers.
- 2. The committee/landowner or anyone acting for these will not be held responsible for any loss/accident to persons, animal or property however caused.
- 3. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
- 4. The judge's decision and that of the official steward is final.
- 5. Questions about the scoring must be made to the secretary. Objections and appeals to be made in writing, accompanied by a £20.00 deposit, within 30 minutes of the incident.
- 6. This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules.
- 7. Vaccination Certificates: As stated in the rules, all BRC qualifying teams must be prepared to show their horse's passports and complete vaccination records on the day of the competition. Chef D'Equipes should ensure these are correct. Any incorrect certificates will result in exclusion from the qualifying competition.
- 8. Entries will not be accepted without the correct fee.
- 9. Competitors must follow the instructions of stewards at all times.
- 10. All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.
- 11. Only persons and/or horses competing may use the warmup facilities. Competitors may only warmup in the designated areas. Lunging is not permitted.
- 12. Horses may not be left unattended tied to horseboxes or trailers. As a courtesy to the landowner please clear all droppings / hay. Park where requested by parking stewards.
- Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear as per BRC rules:
 Hard hats must be worn and chin strap fastened by all riders when mounted.
 All competitors <u>must have a BRC Official hat tag.</u> Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- 14. **Health and Safety** The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials and Stewards. Paramedics are on site for this competition.
- 15. **Legal Liability** Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither West Wilts Equestrian Centre or Bath Riding Club nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted these rules and conditions.
