BRC Area 9 Introductory Championship Qualifier

Qualifies for BRC Introductory Championships on 30th September – 1st October 2023 at Bury Farm Equestrian Village, New Bury Farm, Mill Road, Slapton, Bucks LU7 9BT.

Open to Senior OR Junior teams and individuals (no mixed teams).

Teams of 3 or 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. Each team member must rider a different test - Intro A, Intro B, Prelim 1 & Prelim 2.

Class 1 – Intro A (2008)

Section A: Juniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Section B: Seniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Section C: Open – non qualifier, Individuals only

Class 2 – Intro B (2009)

Section A: Juniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Section B: Seniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Section C: Open – non qualifier, Individuals only

Class 3 – Prelim 1 (2006)

Section A: Juniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Class 4 – Prelim 2 (2016)

Section A: Juniors – Teams/Individual Qualifier

Class BRC Intro Pairs 1 (2022)

Mixed class, for pairs of riders, Seniors and/or Juniors to ride a test together.

Section A: BRC Area 9 Introductory Championship Pairs Qualifier

Eligibility

Intro Tests

Horses/ponies not to have won any BD points at any level or won any BE points. Horses cannot have competed in Novice or above BD or BRC or BE100 in the current or previous competition year, also not have competed at Elementary or above BD or BRC or BE Novice or above in the last 3 calendar years. Riders not to have gained their BHS Stage 4 Coach or above in the past ten years, competed Novice or above BD, BRC or BE 100 in current or previous calendar year or competed Elementary or above BD, BRC or BE Novice or above in the last 3 calendar years. Combinations not to have been placed 1st in their arena at Intro Dressage/Riding Test or above at any BRC Championship in the last 3 calendar years

Prelim Tests

Horses/ponies can have up to 35 BD Prelim and a 0 BD points at Novice or above. Horses cannot have competed in Elementary or above BD or BRC or BE Novice or above in the current or previous competition year, also not have competed at Medium or above BD or BRC or BE Intermediate or above in the last 3 calendar years. Riders not to have gained their BHS Stage 4 Coach or above in the past ten years, competed Elementary or above BD, BRC or BE Novice in current or previous calendar year or competed Medium or above BD, BRC or BE Intermediate or above in the last 3 calendar years. Combinations not to have been placed 1st in their arena at Prelim Dressage/Riding Test or above at any BRC Championship in the last 3 calendar years.

Pairs

Horses/ponies can have up to 35 BD Prelim and a 0 BD points at Novice or above. Riders not to have gained their BHS Stage 4 Coach or above in the past ten years, competed Elementary or above BD, BRC or BE Novice in current or previous calendar year.

Open Sections – Non Qualifiers

Open to all, no restrictions on horse or rider

Entry fees:

Individuals £14.00 per class

Teams: £56.00 per team

Pairs: £16.00 per pair

Rosettes 1st – 6th in all classes

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Anyone not complying with event protocols will be disqualified and asked to leave site immediately. There will be no exceptions to this rule. Any such instances will also be reported to BRC HQ for further disciplinary consideration if deemed appropriate.

Passport checks should be carried out electronically before the event. Team managers should collect this information for their team, check the vaccinations and send them to the designated checker for the event. Area 9 – Penny Ferneyhough, All passports should continue to travel with the horse as it is a legal requirement.

Riders must bring their own bridle numbers / saddle cloth numbers and the competitor numbers should be displayed on bothsides of the horse. Bib numbers may also be worn.

QUALIFYING CLASSES ONLY - Team Managers please ensure horses flu vaccinations are up to date as per BRC 2023 rules and are on the Area Database prior to the competition. Horse Flu vaccination records need to be emailed to area9vaccinations@outlook.com

There will be no scoreboards at the event. Results will be available at www.ridingclubresults.co.uk. Warm up time is limited to 30 minutes prior to your start time. Please follow the stewards instructions at all times.

Qualifier entries must be made on the official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Introductory Area Qualifiers.

Owners and riders enter at their own risk.

The judge's decision in relation to the competition results and that of the official steward in relation to all other matters will be final.

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules 2023. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.

In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of prelim entries.

All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.

Only persons and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities. Competitors may only warm up in the designated area.

Lunging is not permitted.

Horses may not be left unattended tied to horseboxes or trailers.
DO NOT skip lorries out into the car park and please pick up all of your horses dropping, no haynets outside trailers /lorries please.

Please leave your dogs at home.

Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear:

Hard hats must be worn and chin strap fastened by all riders when mounted, conforming to PAS015:2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked. VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked. ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked. SNELL E2016. AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards providing they are SAI global marked. All competitors competing in Area 9 Qualifying classes must have a BRC Official hat tag. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

Health and Safety - The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials and Stewards.

Legal Liability - Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither the committee of Frampton Family Riding Club nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted these rules and conditions.
