**Class 7A & B: Area 9 Junior Team & Individual Qualifier** - For teams of four with the best three scores to count and Individuals. Two team members ride BRC Test BRC HT90Q and 75cm Show Jumping (Class 7A) and two ride BRC Test BRC HT100Q and 85cm Show Jumping (Class 7B)

**Class 8A & B: Area 9 Senior Team & Individual Qualifier** - For teams of four with the best three scores to count and Individuals. Two team members ride BRC Test BRC HT90Q and 75cm Show Jumping (Class 8A) and two ride BRC Test BRC HT100Q and 85cm Show Jumping (Class 8B)

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. The committee/landowner or anyone acting for these will not be held responsible for any loss/accident to persons, animal or property however caused.
2. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
3. The judge's decision and that of the official steward is final.
4. Classes 1-6 may be combined by level, and prizes awarded on percentage if small entries.
5. All phases and classes are run on grass, and so studs are recommended.
6. Questions about the scoring must be made to the secretary. Objections and appeals to be made in writing, accompanied by a £10.00 deposit to the secretary within 10 minutes of the posting of the results of the class.
7. This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules 2016.
8. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.
9. Vaccination Certificates: As stated in the rules, all BRC qualifying teams must be prepared to show their horse's passports and complete vaccination records on the day of the competition. The Chef D' Equip should ensure these are correct. Any incorrect certificates will result in disqualification from the competition.
10. Entries will not be accepted without the correct fee.
11. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of entries.
12. Competitors must follow the instructions of stewards at all times.
13. All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.
14. Only persons and/or horses competing may use the warm up facilities. Competitors may only warm up in the designated area. Lunging is not permitted.
15. Horses may not be left unattended tied to horseboxes or trailers.
16. Please keep your dogs on a lead.
17. Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear: Area 9 competitors must be as below  
**British PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked**  
**VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked**  
**European VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked**  
**American ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001**

Australian & New Zealand AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked  
Failure to have your hat tagged (orange) will result in elimination

18. **Health and Safety** - The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards.
19. **Legal Liability** - Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither the committee of Wessex Gold Riding Club nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.
